Kite Buggies, Blokarts, and Beach Sailors Banned on Fanø and Rømø – Permission to Be Sought

Dear guest,

Our local police authority has, on 28th February, with effect from 1st March, banned the use of kite buggies, blokarts, and beach sailors on the beaches of Fanø and Rømø.

It is the decision of the Police, that the use of kite buggies, blokarts, and beach sailors must now comply with the traffic regulations. In practice, this will make continued use impossible, as it is not realistic to have these vehicles legally approved to meet the requirements of the traffic laws.

We naturally support the idea that all users should be able to move safely on our beaches. However, we firmly believe that it would be possible to allow continued access to the use of kite buggies, blokarts, and beach sailors under safe and responsible conditions.

Long term, we believe the solution could be to create a secure and clearly marked closure of certain beach areas, which could be exempted from the traffic laws, where the use of kite buggies, blokarts, and beach sailors could take place under safe conditions, without disturbing other beachgoers.

In the meantime, the official tourism organization, Vadehavskysten, is immediately applying for temporary permission for driving on existing areas on Fanø.

At the same time, we propose increasing safety in the short term by having all users sign an extended and binding liability declaration, which all beach sailors must carry.

Our application for exemption, along with the proposal for an extended and binding liability declaration, will be submitted to our local police authority today, Sunday, 2nd March. We have reason to believe that the case will be processed quickly.
